Brookfield R-III School District Guidelines for Winter Extra-Curricular and Athletic Events

Due to on-going concerns with the spread of Covid-19, the Brookfield R-III School District has adopted the Clarence Cannon Conference Spectator Guidelines for Winter Activities:



- Each participant will be issued 4 tickets for events in the HS gym and 2 tickets for events in the MS gym to distribute to family/friends. Both the ticket and entry fee MUST be presented for admittance to an event. Certain events may have greater ticket restrictions per participant based on the number of participants/teams competing.
- Cheerleaders will be allowed to attend away games at the schools' discretion.
- 3. There will be no designated student sections.
- 4. There will be no pep band for conference games.
- 5. Concessions will be available with social distancing and sanitation measures in place.
- 6. Visiting fans will sit in the north bleachers and home fans will sit in the south bleachers at BHS. Other conference schools will have fan areas clearly designated.

WE CONTINUE TO EMPHASIZE THE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE

• **STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK-** no spectator should attend a Brookfield R-III athletic or extra-curricular event if they are sick. Please refer to the <u>Daily Wellness Checklist</u> for a self-assessment of whether or not you should be attending an athletic or extra-curricular event.

- **SOCIAL DISTANCE** the Brookfield R-III School District recommends that you sit with your immediate family members and maintain a distance of six feet at all times from other spectators whenever possible.
- WEAR A MASK THAT COVERS YOUR NOSE AND MOUTH- The Brookfield R-III School District recommends that you wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth any time you are not able to maintain six feet of social distancing between yourself and other spectators at an athletic or extracurricular event.
- WASH AND/OR SANITIZE YOUR HANDS THOROUGHLY AND FREQUENTLY-The Brookfield R-III School District recommends that spectators wash and sanitize their hands frequently. Additional hand sanitizer stations will be available at all athletic and extra-curricular events to assist with this process.
- COUGH/SNEEZE INTO A TISSUE OR THE ELBOW OF YOUR SLEEVE- To help prevent the spread of contaminants, please cough and or sneeze into a tissue or the elbow of your shirt sleeve.
- WATCH THE GAMES AND EVENTS VIA LIVESTREAM- Availability and directions for livestreaming events will be posted on the school website and Twitter account.
